

2016 ISLAND WIDE TRAFFIC COLLECTIONS STUDY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The National Road Authority (NRA) is responsible for the planning, construction, supervision and maintenance of Cayman Islands roads. Whose main objective is to ensure the provision of a safe and efficient network to the users. Assuming that traffic data is the basis of the ground transport system, this information serves as a tool in the process to make better decisions and with more support. Which almost always they are involved in the allocation of funds for continuous improvement of transport. So the impact that involves collecting traffic data, is extremely important. On this occasion the NRA has decided to conduct a traffic study of wide coverage, after about 17 years since the last study of this kind.
