### NEWS DESCRIPTION

**Traffic flow on Albert Panton Street, between Kirk House and the Legislative Assembly building, will permanently change from one-way to two-way in mid-January 2008.**

Traffic flow on Albert Panton Street, between Kirk House and the Legislative Assembly building, will permanently change from one-way to two-way in mid-January 2008.

This change in circulation is being implemented in anticipation of Butterfield Bank's new parking garage opening. It is designed to improve traffic flow within the downtown area.

"By making Albert Panton Street a two-way road from Kirk House to Fort Street, users of the new parking facility will now have an optional route to exit the downtown area. Traffic will be redirected away from Cardinal Avenue - a street that sees high pedestrian volumes on cruise ship days," said National Roads Authority Deputy Managing Director Edward Howard.

He added that curbside parking from Kirk House to the Fort Street Market will be eliminated to accommodate this change. However, current curb-side parking along the courthouse will not be affected.

The remaining section of Albert Panton Street, from Kirk House to Cardinal Avenue, will remain a one-way connector.
